- whereas, the Collin County Alumnae Chapter is one of more than 1000 chapters of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated, an organization of college-educated women committed to constructive development of its members and to public service with a primary focus on the Black community; and
- whereas, the Collin County Alumnae Chapter will celebrate 10 years of sisterhood, scholarship and service within Collin County with a current membership of 222 college-educated professionals which includes educators, doctors, nurses, lawyers, entrepreneurs, accountants, and business analysts, to name a few; and
- WHEREAS, the Collin County Alumnae Chapter actively provides continuous community programs throughout the cities of Allen, Anna, Fairview, Frisco, Lucas, McKinney, Melissa, Murphy, Parker, Prosper, Sachse and Wylie; and
- whereas, the Collin County Alumnae Chapter actively supports volunteerism and charitable activities mandated by a five-point programmatic thrust that promotes Economic and Educational Development, International Awareness and Involvement, Physical and Mental Health and Political Awareness and Involvement; and
