- LMI homeowners, often disabled & elderly

- La Loma 84% impact
- Rockwall 42% impact
- Lewisville 35% impact
- Mouzon 21% impact
- Wilcox 12% impact
- Rockwall 2 6% impact

Continued Need for Affordable Housing

- Impact assessment identified 29% of La Loma Homes need repair work.
- Over 100 on Habitat wait list.
- Average McKinney home value \$296,500

Application Requests – \$160,850 for Land Acquisition

 $5 \text{ Lots } \times \$25,000 = \$160,850$














Land Acquisition -Concept for Bumpas Lot
