A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE DEPUTY CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND IMPLEMENT URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY THROUGH THE NORTH TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (NCTCOG) TO PURCHASE HANDHELD RADIOS FOR THE CITY OF MCKINNEY CRISIS ACTION TEAM (COMCAT)

- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, understands the importance enhancing regional security and emergency preparedness; and
- WHEREAS, the grant will provide funding to purchase fifteen (15) handheld radios to enhance communications between the CAT team and the Emergency Operations Center during an emergency affecting City facilities; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the UASI funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) in full; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the agreement on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby approves the Section 1. acceptance and implementation of the grant award of Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) funding through the North Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) to purchase fifteen (15) handheld radios.
- Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
