

## City of McKinney Substantial Amendment to the PY 2019-20 CDBG Annual Action Plan

The City of McKinney respectfully informs the public about the Substantial Amendment under the FY 2019-2020 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) annual action plan. The city receives CDBG funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The Annual Action Plan serves to identify the housing and community development needs, priorities, goals, and strategies; and to stipulate how funds will be allocated to housing and community development activities. Each year, the Annual Action Plan describes how funds will be used.

HUD approved the plan for program year of October 1, 2019 – September 30, 2020. Under the city's Citizen Participation Plan, in the case of certain changes to the Consolidated Plan or an Annual Action Plan, the city will propose a substantial amendment.

Summary of Change Request (Change of Scope in use of funds)

- To address the response of homelessness, the City of McKinney was awarded a FY 2019 Continuum of Care grant in the amount of \$ 306,978 to provide rapid rehousing services, to assist a minimum of 12 homeless families for up to 12 months, with housing assistance with utility/security deposits and moving expenses. Case Management Services will be funded through the grant and provided by The Samaritan Inn.
- Rapid re-housing is an intervention, informed by a Housing First approach that is a
  critical part of a community's effective homeless crisis response system. Rapid
  re-housing rapidly connects families and individuals experiencing homelessness to
  permanent housing through a tailored package of assistance that may include the use
  of time-limited financial assistance and targeted supportive services.
- There will be no financial change to the city's awarded CDBG allocation and no additional staff is required and the action does not impact relocation of residents.
   There is no impact to the general fund. The grant and the program year of the grant will begin August 3, 2020.
