A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH COLLIN COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF COSTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$24,000.00 RELATED TO CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES OF THE WATER LINE INSTALLATION ALONG THE PUBLIC SAFETY TRAINING FACILITY SITE

- **WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the citizens of McKinney for local governments to cooperate, where possible, in the provision of governmental functions and services where such cooperation will result in a more efficient, higher quality and/or more cost-effective provision of such functions and services; and
- WHEREAS, the City and College are authorized to enter into an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement under Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code for the provision of governmental functions and services; and
- WHEREAS, the College is in the process of constructing the Facility and the City desires to also construct a fifty-four-inch (54") diameter water line ("Water Line") along and across a portion of the frontage of the land along Redbud Boulevard; and
- WHEREAS, the City has discussed entering into an Interlocal Agreement with Collin County Community College District for the construction and reimbursement of costs related to construction activities of the Water Line installation; and
- **WHEREAS**, the College and the City desire to further work together and coordinate their efforts to minimize and reduce any conflicts that may arise out of the two construction projects upon and across the land.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Collin County Community College District for the construction and reimbursement of costs in the amount of \$24,000.00 related to construction activities of the Water Line installation along the Public Safety Training Facility Site.
- Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
