



## **PROS Advisory Board & MCDC Joint Meeting**

- 1. We need to realize more small- to mid-scale accomplishments within a *1-year cycle*, rather than funding such work over numerous years, and
- 2. We must identify a couple of *visionary projects* to include not just new projects, but also major renovations to our existing assets (e.g. Towne Lake).

With this insight, we calibrated our plan over the next couple of years to achieve some great near-term wins as well as prime the pump for various visionary projects.

Our aim is to complete a lot of mid-sized projects over the next 18-months and get them off our books!






