- Location: Murray Addition, Block 1, Lot 2



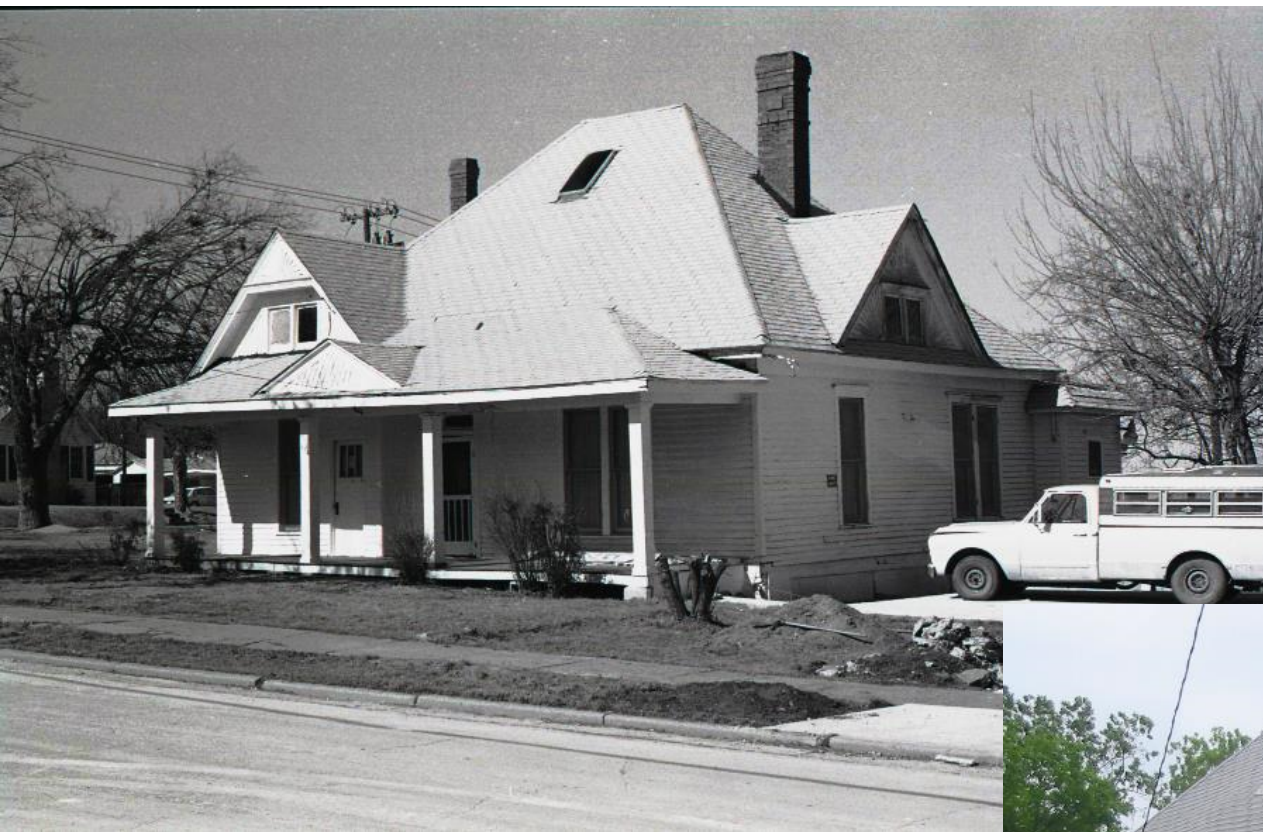

1905 Photo shows the original owners Margaret Rector and Lee M. Talkington and granddaughter Margaret Warden.

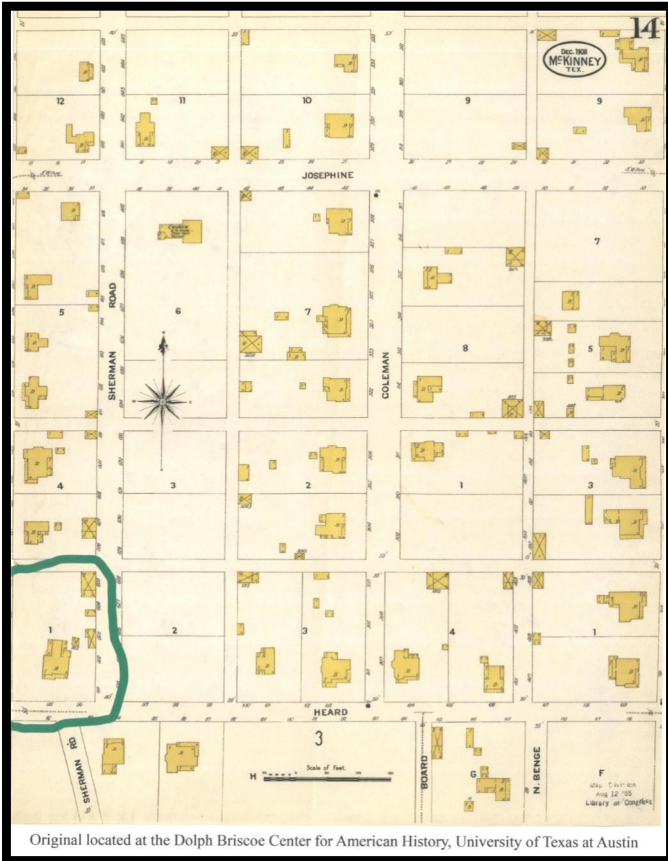

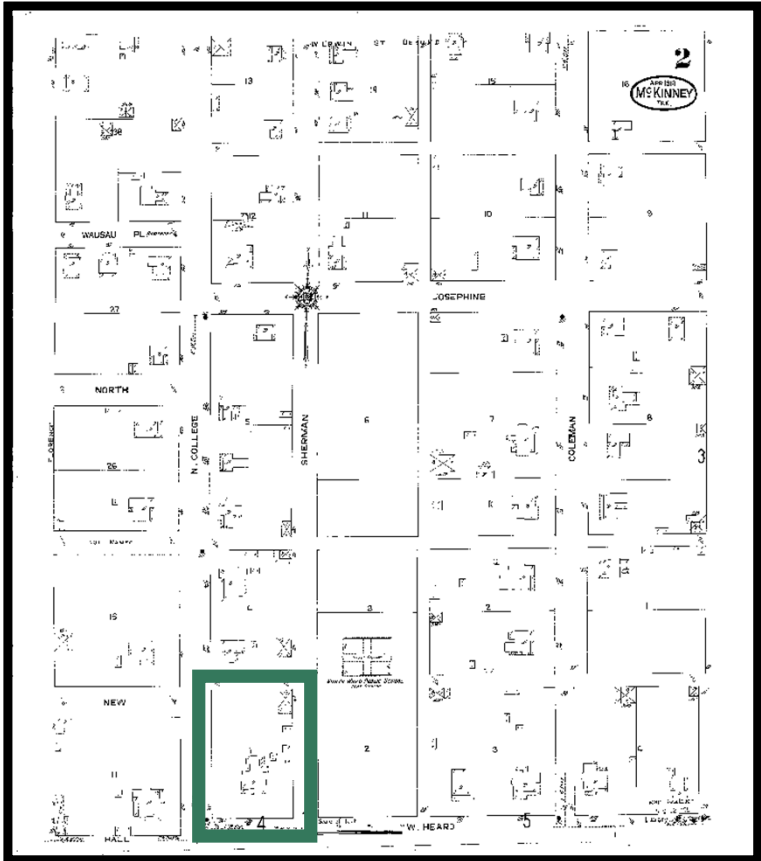
