## Final Report Narrative for McKinney Repertory Theatre 2017-2018 Season

McKinney Repertory Theatre recently completed its 15<sup>th</sup> season labeled "A Season of Comedy". We opened our season with *Murder in the Magnolias*, a funny and clever spoof of "Southern" plays by Tim Kelly with six performances on October 13, 14, 15, 20, and 21. Total attendance was 463.

In November and December we performed our annual production of *A Christmas Carol*, an adaption by McKinney resident Dr. Andrew Harris. An annual Holiday favorite, total attendance for the nine performances was 1780. Performances were November 24, 25, and 26, during McKinney's Home For The Holidays, and December 15 and 16. For the fourth year, we also did a staged reading at the Collin County Juvenile Detention Center. This year residents of the Center also participated in the reading.

Our third show of the season was Paul Rudnick's *I Hate Hamlet*, a comedy about a television actor temporarily moving to New York to perform *Hamlet* in Central Park. When he rents an apartment that was once owned by John Barrymore, he inadvertently summons Barrymore to help him with the role. Attendance was 415, with six performances on February 23, 24, 25, and March 2 and 3.

Our next production was *A Bad Year for Tomatoes* by John Patrick. Myra Marlowe, a successful actress, has come to a small New England town to 'get away from it all' for awhile. She wants to relax and grow tomatoes and be left alone, but the townspeople are intrigued by their new resident. In order to get them to leave her in peace, she fabricates a crazy sister to keep them away. Unfortunately, that only escalates her problems! Attendance was 416 for the six performances on May 11, 12, 13, 18, and 19.

Our fifth and final production of the season was our annual melodrama, a popcorn throwing, audience participation show. This year's production was *The Face on the Barroom Floor (or Glimpsed Through the Sawdust)* by Tim Kelly. The show revolves around a young chambermaid, Madelaine Mockingbird, who inherits money from a miner she can't remember. She is in love with Jack 'Toulouse' Goodhart and fancies herself a singer and would like to have a stage career. The only problem is that she can't sing. This does not deter our villain, Roderick Rodent, from trying to steal her money and discredit her fiance. There were nine performances on July 27, 28, 29, and August 4, 5, 10, and 11. Total attendance was 731.
