

McKINNEY ARTS COMMISSION

AUGUST 11, 2017

The McKinney Arts Commission of the City of McKinney, Texas met in regular session in the 2nd floor Conference Room of the Municipal Building on August 11, 2017, at 8:30 a.m.

Commissioners Present: Pamela Harden, Tricia Conover, Greg Huckaby, and Jeffery Hull.

Absent: Sandra Doak, Molly Brewer, and Michele Andriola.

Staff Present: Janay Tieken, Housing & Community Development Manager; and Judy Hawkins, Administrative Assistant.

Chairman Harden called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. after determining a quorum present.

17-786 Consider/Discuss 2017-2018 Art Grant Applicant Presentations. Anne Royer, Arts & Music Guild, requested \$8,025 to support the Summer Music Incentives. Jason Lim, Odysseus Chamber Orchestra, requested \$20,000 to support four seasonal concerts, a young artist's viola competition, school tour concerts, a free chamber music concert, and the Summer Music Intensives. NTC ATOS, represented by Al Cavitt, requested \$5,983 to support their four-program season. Jake Correll spoke for McKinney Repertory Theatre. They are requesting \$17,023.50 to support the actors' and directors' salaries. Young Actors Guild President Jimmy Teeling thanked the commissioners for their past support and requested \$18,000 to support their 16 seasonal performances. The Texas Chinese Performing Arts, represented by David Wong, requested \$4,950 to support a performance planned in August, 2018. The McKinney Community Concert Association is requesting \$20,000 to support their seven seasonal programs. They were represented by Dinah Martin. Jennifer Dulin, Youth Ballet of Texas, requested grant funds of \$5,325 to support five live performances and a two-day workshop. Eduardo Gutierrez, Ollimpaxqui Mexican Ballet, requested \$15,000 to support their May 5, 2018 performance, two

additional community events, and 5-7 double performances in MISD elementary schools. Devon Miller and Megan Carfa, representing Junior Players, requested \$9,000 to help them provide high quality arts instruction for youth who may not have the opportunity otherwise.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:30 a.m.
