



**TITLE:** Consider/Discuss/Act on an Ordinance Amending the 2012-13 Annual Budget from the Golf Course Fund Balance for Irrigation Repairs at Oak Hollow Golf Course

**ITEM SUMMARY:**

- This Ordinance authorizes \$206,218 from the Golf Course Fund Balance for the repairs of irrigation at the Oak Hollow Golf Course.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- The irrigation at the Oak Hollow Golf Course was damaged by lightning strikes.
- Maintenance concerns of the course turf were brought to the attention of the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Department.
- Without a fully functioning irrigation system, the quality of the course would be damaged beyond repair.
- The repairs included in this item will restore the irrigation system to its previous operational condition. However, staff cannot determine how long the irrigation system will last without a complete system upgrade.

**FINANCIAL SUMMARY:**

- This Ordinance authorizes \$206,218 of the Golf Course Fund Balance to be used for the repair of irrigation at the Oak Hollow Golf Course.
