Administration

- MEDC Project Record Management
 - Staff commenced working the reorganization/standardization of MEDC Project Record Management since October 20.
 - Staff led MEDC team, Temp Robinson and Administration
 Assistant Hass, to streamline/standardize the record management of MEDC current and past agreements.
 - MEDC team works closely with City Secretary Hart to be in sync with the City's record management system.
 - Staff established four phases to complete the project. Phase I & II involves current projects. Phase III & IV will be the historical agreements.
 - Two major categories for each project: the legal agreements and the compliance documents.
 - Will create the electronics library of current and past project.
 - Phase I is completed.
- A Successful Partnership between MEDC & MPAC/Main Street
 - With Mayor Pro Tem Ussery's vision and initiatives, Staff has been working with Director Rosenthal to promote MPAC/Main Street to McKinney businesses and international associations in DFW Metroplex.




