CITY OF MCKINNEY – ARTS COMMISSION 2014/2015 GRANT YEAR FINAL GRANT REPORT – SUMMARY FINAL NARRATIVE

The McKinney Community Band (MCB) had a very successful season.

Our performances included:

- 1. Public concerts at McKinney Performing Arts Center and Christ Fellowship Church:
 - "The Spirit of Christmas" Holiday Concert, Dec. 12, 2014 (Church)
 - "Let's Dance" Concert, March 21, 2015 (Church)
 - "America!" Concert, June 27, 2015 (MPAC)
- 2. "Jammin' in June" Concert, June 25, 2015 (Bonnie Wenk Park)
- 3. "Music in Motion", Oct. 10, 2014 (Heard Craig Performing Arts Center) Dance Band and Flute Choir

MCB was supposed to play at the Memorial Day Ceremony at Pecan Grove Cemetery on May 25, 2015, but the event was cancelled due to flooding. We are scheduled to perform next year again.

Our success can be measured in many ways:

- 1. Continuing with our mission to provide performances, free of charge, to residents of McKinney, thus helping to promote the arts community in McKinney.
- 2. Providing audiences with performances that are not only musically sound, but also engaging.
- 3. Exposing audiences to a wide variety of music, thus enhancing their appreciation and knowledge of music and arts overall.
- 4. Featured in McKinney Magazine March 2015 edition.
- 5. Purchased two timpani, which were debuted at our March concert. This addition to our percussion adds the richness and "bottom" sound needed by a band.
- 6. Providing an outlet for individuals to pursue their love of music, improve their skills, and perform.
- 7. Increasing public promotion and revenue streams through promotions such as North Texas Giving Day, Amazon Smile, and TI Matching program.
- 8. Continuing our band camp scholarship to Scott Johnson Middle School.
- 9. Continuing to improve our overall sound and quality, which in turn benefits the community through improved performances and involvement and attracts and keeps high caliber members.

Our two smaller ensembles, The Flute Choir and The Dance Band, perform throughout McKinney and North Texas at smaller venues and gigs, such as retirement communities, churches, the Lions Organization, Baylor Hospital, and the McKinney Garden Club. MCB also performs an annual holiday concert at Highland Springs Retirement Center. And, while these performances are not necessarily open to the public, they do provide additional revenue to the band and another way for us to promote our organization.

The McKinney Community Band thanks the City of McKinney and its Arts Commission for its support this past 2014-2015 Grant Year. We look forward to performing throughout McKinney again in 2015 and 2016.
