

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-04-____ (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH CAPCO, INC., FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE EXTENSION OF FIBER OPTIC CABLE FROM THE INTERSECTION OF CUSTER ROAD AND COTTON RIDGE SOUTH TO THE GABE NESBITT PARK FACILITY, AND ANY NECESSARY SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENTS UNDER SAID CONTRACT UP TO AN AGGREGATE CONTRACT AMOUNT, INCLUSIVE OF SAID SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENTS, NOT TO EXCEED \$180,000

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, recognizes the need for extension of fiber optic network; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, authorizes local governments to contract directly with other governments to increase their efficiency and effectiveness. Texas Government Code, Section 791.025(c) states that a local government that purchases goods and any services reasonably required for the installation, operation or maintenance of those goods under the Interlocal Cooperation Act satisfies the requirement of the local government to seek competitive bids for the purchase of goods and their services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The Interim City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract in the amount of \$180,000 with Capco, Inc., to extend the fiber optic cable from the intersection of Custer Road and Cotton Ridge South to the Gabe Nesbitt Park Facility, and authorizing all necessary supplemental agreements under said contract up to an aggregate contract amount, inclusive of said supplemental agreements, not to exceed \$180,000.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
