**NARRATIVE SUMMARY: McKinney Arts Commission Grant**

Beethoven Symphony No. 9  
First Baptist Church, McKinney  
April 24, 2015

The Frisco Chorale joined forces with the Odysseus Chamber Orchestra in the spring of 2015 in a concert for the McKinney, TX audience of the rousing Symphony No. 9 of Ludwig van Beethoven. This concert work has for almost 200 years been proclaimed the "Choral Symphony" – as the required forces are orchestra and chorus. The performance was presented at McKinney's First Baptist Church on April 24, 2015 at 8pm. The concert was outstanding, evidenced by the rapturous standing ovation concluding the performance.

The concert attendees were on a smaller scale than desired. This is likely due to the severe thunderstorm which swept through the area during the afternoon and evening hours of the concert day. Attendance numbers were close to 60 persons. Nevertheless, both ensembles performed with intense professionalism and renewed vigor to bring orchestral and choral art on a heightened scale to future McKinney performances.

The chorus was rehearsed by Kendall Carter, Music Director of the Frisco Chorale. The concert was conducted by the Music Director of the orchestra, Jason Lim. The concert began with an orchestral interpretation of a Mozart symphonic work followed by the hallmark Beethoven work. The entire concert duration was approximately 1-hour, 15-minutes.
