2015-2016 Young Actors Guild McKinney Arts Commission Grant Final Report

The Young Actors Guild is wrapping up another successful season, its seventh. We have maintained membership of about 70 youth since its inception.

The first production of our 2015-2016 season was *Just Add Zombies* and *10 Ways to Survive the Zombie Apocalypse* with four performances on November 20, 21, and 22, 2015. We had a youth cast and crew of 16 youth, with an audience of 118.

YAG performed Zink: the Myth, the Legend, the Zebra on February 19, 20, and 21, 2016 with a cast and crew of 28 youth. Attendance for the four performances was 227.

We performed our annual Shakespeare play with four performances on April 29 and 30 and May 1, 2016. This year's production was a hip hop version of *Comedy of Errors*. We had a cast and crew of 26, with an audience of 183.

In June, we held our 11th Children's Summer Music Theatre Camp. This is the third year as part of the Young Actors Guild, though it doesn't fit the criteria of a YAG production because participants do not have to be a member of YAG to participate. It is a youth production, though, and several YAG members participate every year. This year's production was *Seussical, Jr.* The camp ran from June 6-19, 2016, with 38 youth participating. Attendance for the four performances on June 17, 18, and 19 was 477.

We also had 12 youth travel to Baytown, Texas in June to perform *Greek Mythology Olympiaganza* at the Texas Nonprofit Theatre Association's annual Youth Conference. This is the sixth year YAG has participated and it's a great experience for the youth. They attend workshops on different aspects of theatre and interact with youth from other theatre companies from all over Texas. No McKinney Arts Commission money is spent on this activity. Each participant paid about \$300.00 to cover the cost of participating.

Our final production of the seas was *Law and Order Fairy Tale Unit* with four performances on July 22, 23, and 24, 2016. There was a cast and crew of 28, and a total attendance of 210.

YAG had several fundraisers this year. We participated in North Texas Giving Day earning \$927.47 Our youth members and adult volunteers helped out at the City of McKinney's Oktoberfest earning \$500.00 for our organization. We had a fundraising performance of *Murder in the Knife Room* where we raised \$1601. Through GoFundMe, we raised \$683.32. We participated in a fundraiser at Raising Cane's earning \$50.00 and a fundraiser at Panera earning \$172.63. By selling concessions throughout the year, we raised \$3,260.00

All performances were held at the McKinney Performing Arts Center, with the exception of *Greek Mythology Olympiaganza*.
