Post Grant Narrative

The Art Club of McKinney 2012-2013

The Art Club of McKinney hosted two events this year that were funded in part by a grant awarded by the City of McKinney Arts Commission. The events were held together on April 5-7, 2013 at the Heard-Craig Gallery. The Collin County Student Art Show was held upstairs and the 49th Annual Collin County Adult Art Show was held downstairs in the Heard-Craig Hall.

The student art show was open to all currently enrolled high school students in Collin County, Texas. Included were students in public, private and home schooled students. This year we had 109 participants displaying 191 pieces of art work. Seventeen hundred dollars (\$1700) in cash prizes was awarded, as well as ribbons. Four hundred eighty three (483) visited the Student Art Show this year. Entry fees collected for this shows amounted to \$1,090.

The 49th Annual Collin County Adult Art Show entrants were adults age 18 and older who either reside in Collin County, Texas or are involved in an arts organization in Collin County. Fifty five (55) individuals entered this contest displaying one hundred thirty one (131) pieces of art work. There were three hundred seven (307) visitors to the Adult Art Show. Entry fees collected for this shows amounted to \$1,815.

The shows brought close to 800 visitors to McKinney over the course of the three day event. In summary, the weekend of art shows given by The Art Club of McKinney proved once again to be a success.

As an experiment, it was voted by the Board Members to combine the two art shows for the first time. The combination of the two shows proved to be more cost effective this year and resulted in our coming in under budget, but this may not be feasible every year.
