"To Serve Our Community by Revealing Our Past to Make History Relevant to All"

The Collin County Historical Society & Museum was established in 1957 and incorporated as a 501 (C) (3) in 1984. The Society is dedicated to increasing understanding of North Texas history through exhibitions, public programs, online outreach, and research that reveal our collective history. Our holdings cover three centuries of North Texas history including historical artifacts, documents, American Art, photographs, and other materials documenting the history of North Texas.

We are the primary repository of historical artifacts and documents for Collin County, although our collections and archive include materials from Denton, Hunt, Fannin, Grayson, Red River and Dallas Counties.

Our collections and archive provide a foundation for exploration of North Texas history and support the Society's mission to provide a basis for debate and examination of issues surrounding the meaning of our local cultural history.

We respectfully request a \$5000 grant to help us promote and market:

'THE VIETNAM SYNDROME' EXHIBIT

In 1955, U.S. policymakers viewed the conflict in Vietnam as a broader struggle with the Soviet Union. It was widely believed from the outset that Ho Chi Minh and his followers were instruments of the Soviet drive for world domination. In many of our leaders' opinion at the time, if Vietnam fell, all of Southeast Asia would be lost. America's involvement in Vietnam, Laos, and Cambodia officially began 01.11.1955 and continued through the fall of Saigon on

America's involvement in the Vietnam War still remains a controversial topic. Many people today do not have a clear idea of why our country was engaged in this conflict. An even larger concern to us is that our youth, the future leaders and citizens of our nation, have no experience of the war and little or no knowledge of it. Our schools, entrusted with passing on our common heritage, have all but ignored the Vietnam War years. Many of our young people do not understand the comparisons between the Vietnam War and today's conflicts in the middle east.

The Collin County Historical Society & Museum will mount an exhibit in which local Vietnam Veterans tell of their experiences fighting in Southeast Asia between 1965 and 1975. We will investigate who were the typical American soldiers, how they dealt with transitioning to a peacetime existence, particularly without federal programs to help veterans and their families cope with postwar life at home.

'The Vietnam Syndrome' will explore our Veteran's experiences as they returned home to an largely angry, non-supportive, and hostile American public. We will explore the cultural impact of the era such as the anti-war movement, music, fashion, increased drug use and more. It was a confusing time for everyone.

Our community owes these brave men and women the opportunity to tell their story in a safe environment. Young people should have the chance to hear the stories directly from those who lived through the war rather than from a textbook or, in many cases, not at all.

This exhibit will allow for an understanding of the challenges our Veterans and their families at home endured during the Vietnam War years. Additionally, it will provide discussion topics for the conflicts our nation engages in today.

We are partnering with VFW Lone Star Post 2150 and the American Legion Post 96 in McKinney to create the content for the exhibit. Many members have generously volunteered to help us mount the exhibit as well.

As a recent case study to support our request, we can confirm admission numbers to our WWII exhibit, 'The Texas War Machine of WWII', which closed in April 2014, of 998 visitors. Many came from various regions throughout Texas, from New Jersey, New York, Minnesota, Florida, California, from the UK, Germany, Spain, and the Ukraine.

Our team believes the attendance goal for the exhibit should be double that of our WWII Exhibit, 'The Texas War Machine'. Nothing would be more satisfying than for this goal to become a reality.

"The Vietnam Syndrome' falls into the category of 'authentic' cultural and heritage tourism. McKinney markets itself as a great tourism destination and this exhibit brings a legitimate, thoughtful, and significant historical experience to the citizens of McKinney. It will bring visitors from Collin County, other parts of Texas, and the United States to McKinney.

While our tourists are visiting downtown McKinney, they will shop, eat, perhaps see a show, and enjoy a beautifully developed historic downtown.

Our main goal for exhibition expansion is to create traveling exhibits based on the fixed annual exhibits we mount here at the museum. Each year we host one major exhibit and one mini exhibit. Traveling exhibits can provide revenue in perpetuity if they are professionally built and marketed. Our goal is to begin with our WWII exhibit and move forward from there.

The topic of the War in Vietnam, the 'living room war', has not been presented to the general public by museums throughout the United States as aggressively as with other wars. Our Vietnam Veterans should have the same opportunity to tell about their experiences in Southeast Asia and the trials they endured upon returning home.

Educate the community about the impact of MCDC investments on quality of life in McKinney

The Vietnam War is a topic people above the age of 40 are still debating after four generations. It was a time of permanent cultural change in this country and it still affects many peoples' lives. Our visitors will benefit greatly by revisiting the Vietnam Era and being given the opportunity to refine their personal views. McKinney will be part of a thought provoking experience not available anywhere else in North Texas. It will be a unique exhibit for a unique City.
