## **The McKinney Garden Club**

#### Signature Beautification Projects Long Term Plan

- 1. Partner with the Parks Department on the design and construction of a wooden bridge to cross the creek in Finch Park toward the gazebo, near our Lovejoy Memorial Garden, and plant daffodils among the trees we planted there so many years ago.
- 2. Begin an ongoing program of mass the planting of bulbs. The Phase One proposal calls for a first planting of 9000 Bulbs. Daffodils, Guernsey Lilies and Muscari will be used. Each bed will also have an accent planting of one evergreen such as Candytuft, Pink Thrift, Yellow Daylilies and Blue Lirope Muscari. The plantings will be spread across the City in prepared median beds on major thoroughfares and woodland areas that are not mowed in City Parks.

This project, tentatively approved by the Parks Dept., Engineering Dept. and the City Arborist, would be funded by the Garden Club and hopefully, a matching grant from McKinney Community Development Corporation, (MCDC). A matching grant, if awarded, would allow for the immediate planting of Phase Two, another 9000 bulbs.

The prominent colors of these Blub Plantings would be yellow, blue and fuchsia. This look would become a Signature for future Garden Club plantings and these colors are in keeping with the colors to be used at 121 and 75 and the landscaping of State Highway 75, as the new construction is completed. Our legacy of beautification will grow again.

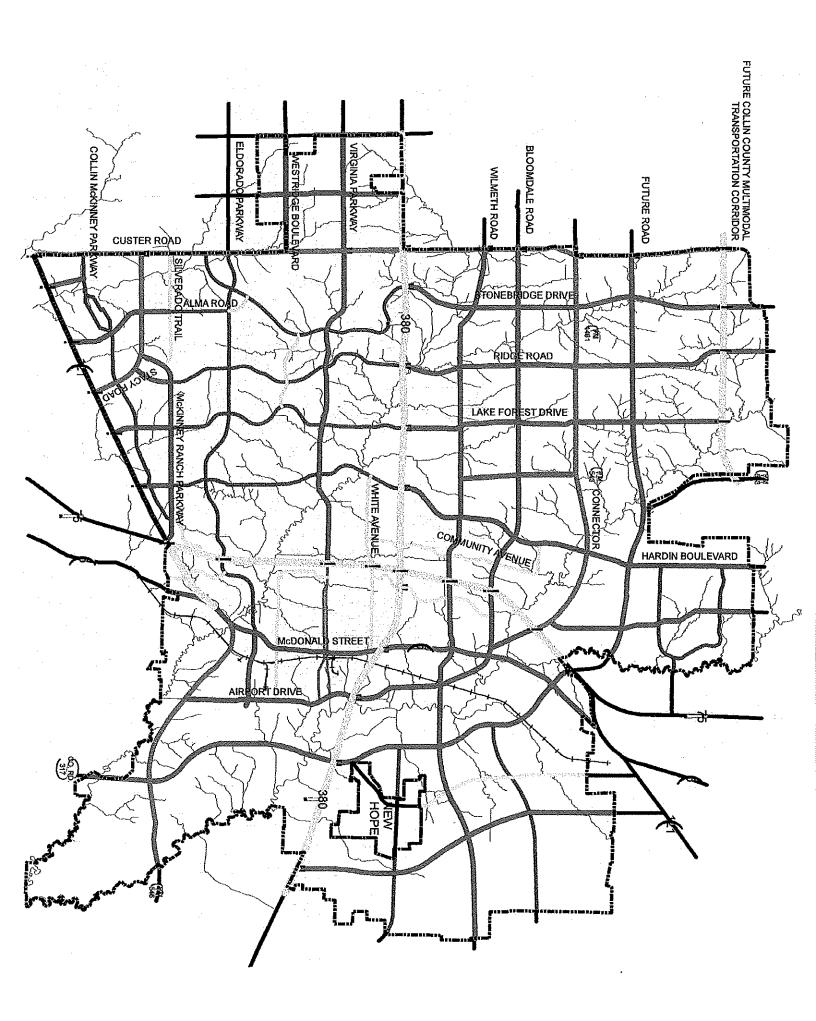

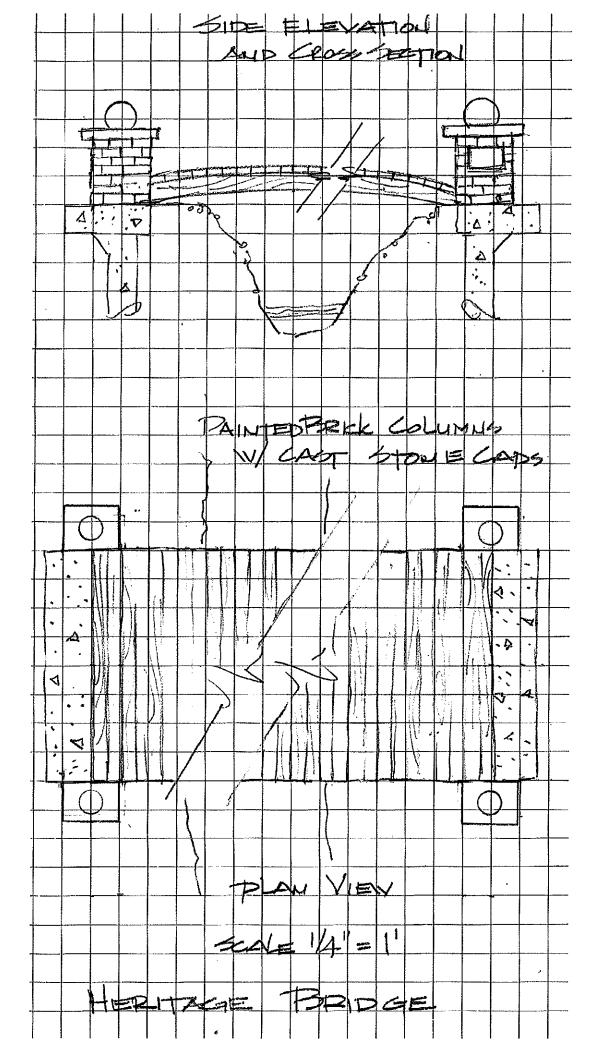

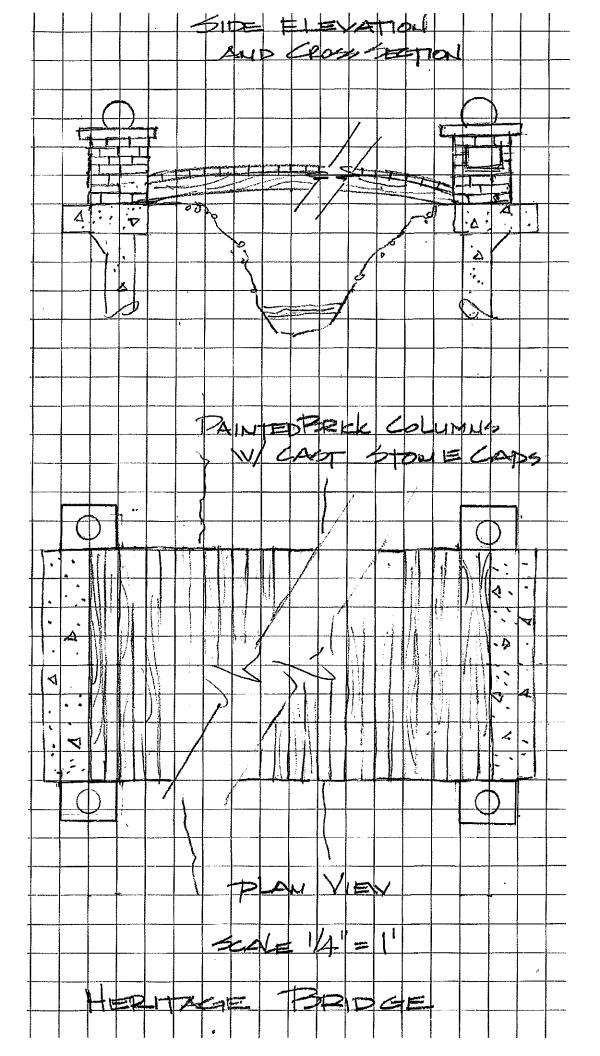

Signature Beautification Project - Typical Plan 2012

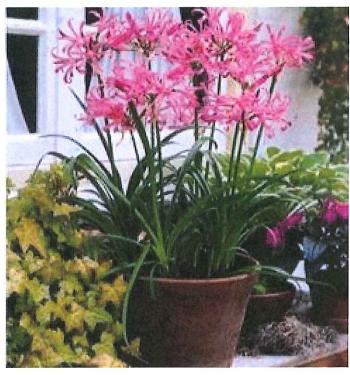
