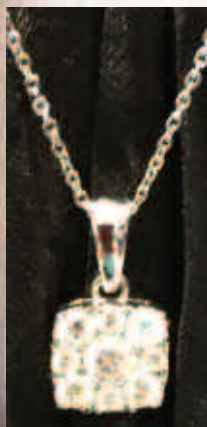

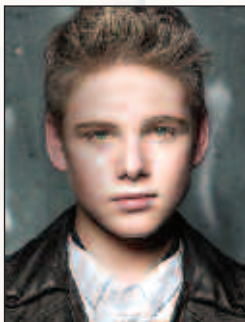


Colton Jacobson opens this year's event

Colton Jacobson is a 16-year-old recording artist (singer/songwriter) from Dallas, TX. At the young age of 14, Colton found his passion, music. With a piano and a video recorder, the young pop singer quickly found his audience when he introduced himself via YouTube with his amazing home videos covering songs such as "It Will Rain" by Bruno Mars, which earned him the #2 most shared video on YouTube during that period, "Halo" by Beyoncé and "Someone Like You" by Adele.

Colton has become one of YouTube's most promising young artists, with over 6 million views. The singer has gained over 36,000 Facebook likes and 165,000 Twitter followers.

As a result of Colton's growing success as a performer, he and his band opened for legendary rocker Bret Michaels of POISON in May 2014 and pop music icon KARMIN in July 2014. Colton has also previously opened for Jason Castro of American Idol and was sponsored by Gibson Guitars as a featured artist/performer at the Gibson JAM Sessions during the National Association of Music Manufacturers (NAMM) Convention in Anaheim, CA., where he shared the stage with celebrities such as Tommy Thayer of KISS, Earl Slick, guitarist for Billy Idol and actor Eddie Cahill, CSI:NY. Colton has also given back to his community by helping raise money for many charities that support families of our fallen heroes like Snowball Express & Carry The Load along with several local charities such as Foster Kids Charity - Dal-



las and Boys & Girls Club of North Texas to name a few.

In Spring 2015, Colton will be headlining the Teen Nation Tour to help bring awareness to the epidemic of bullying in our schools. For more information on the tour, go to www.ColtonJacobson.com/tour-dates.

Colton took his music to a new level when he recorded his first studio album "Unstoppable" in 2012. When recording the project, the young artist knew he was on a path to deliver a message that would impact the youth of today. He wanted to use his music to help bring awareness to the epidemic of bullying. "Unstoppable" the title track from his album, was written to speak to all ages and to bring awareness to bullying. Colton knows first hand what it is like to be bullied at an early age for being different. The album "Unstoppable" was released in January 2013 with great success and is currently available for download on iTunes.

In 2013, Colton was asked to become a National Spokesperson for PACER National Bullying Prevention Center alongside pop sensation Demi Lovato in an effort to help support PACER's cause in educating kids, teachers and parents on how to overcome and/or prevent bullying in our schools.

Dylan Scott

A native of northeast Louisiana, Dylan Scott is making waves in Nashville as a result of his first single "Making This Boy Go Crazy" selling over 130,000 units and having in excess of 2,000,000 views of the accompanying video. Now the multi-talented Sidewalk Records Artist is poised to become a major star with his new self-titled CD, Dylan Scott, featuring five modern, progressive songs he co-wrote with the best of Nashville's new generation of songwriters. The CD, produced by Music City legend, Jim Ed Norman, is self-named for more than the obvious reasons: "It says everything about me, honestly," explains the 24 year old, whose speaking voice is as soulful as his singing. "There's not a song on there that doesn't relate to who I am."

Take, for example, "Turn Rows", a perfect nugget of spirited rural fun and youthful enterprise in the cornfields. Or "Granddaddy's Gun", which captures the rite of passage for a boy who grows-up bonding with the men who teach him the ways of the woods.

"There's a spiritual quality to hunting," shares this avid outdoorsman, talking about his favorite pastime. "I usually sit in the stand by myself. It's nice and quiet. You don't hear anything but wind and birds. You watch the sun come up. It's a peaceful thing." Almost everything in his life has been a natural fit...starting with the music itself. If he sings about it he's done it. You might say it's in his blood. His father, Scotty, played guitar and sang harmony in the '70's and '80's with country Artists, Freddy Fender and Freddy Hart. Dylan's great Aunt, Marie Jarvis, played piano with the Southern Gospel group, The Melody Boys and taught piano at The Stamps Baxter School Of Music. She would sit Dylan on her lap when he was two and teach him the rudiments of the keyboard. Dylan's cousin, Linda Robinson Scholar, played for The Speer Family, The Downings, The Higher Ground and briefly with The Stamps Quartet (which backed Elvis). She also taught piano to the famed piano-man, producer and record executive, Tony Brown who played with both J.D. Summers and The Stamps as well as having production credits for George Strait and Reba McEntire to name a few.

It was around this age of two that Dylan's father noticed the toddler could sing on key. In the next few years, almost everybody commented on his voice. "Ever since I was real young," he remembers, "people said, 'You have a deep voice to be so little.' Since my dad was in the business, I thought, 'oh, everybody's in the music business. That's what I've got to do when I get older.'" By the age of 12, Scott was proficient on acoustic guitar and dreaming of a future on stage. By his high school years, he was performing with the Gospel



trio, 11th Hour, traveling throughout the South to appear at fairs, festivals and churches

It was old-school country Merle Haggard and George Strait that really caught his ear and he heard something special in the plaintive sounds of Keith Whitley, who died the year before Dylan was born. "Keith was my musical role model. Talking about him is like talking about Elvis to me. I love how smooth his voice was."

He dreamed of moving to Nashville to become the next Keith Whitley and carry the banner for pure honky-tonk while he honed his chops at high profile shows around the state, including the renowned Louisiana Hayride. But when he arrived in Music City and began writing more and more, fueling his absolute passion for songwriting, his style broadened into an edgier sound. From the sexy groove of "Mmm, Mmm, Mmm," to the get-the-party-started punch of "Twangin'," Scott's original songs have proven undeniably infectious. His ballads, too, show a mature songwriter whose work is likely to be recorded by other Artists. "Good Town," for example, resonates with anyone who is proud of the place that made him who he is.

Scott's own hometown, Bastrop, located near Monroe, LA, is where he returns to his family when he's not in Nashville or on the road. There, he worked construction and became a part-time fitness trainer before scoring his record deal at age 19. "It was great growing up in Louisiana, twenty minutes to the nearest anything, and being able to walk outside and jump on a four-wheeler and go riding wherever you wanted on a back road."

Rodney Atkins is as authentic as they come. Whether he's taking in a baseball game with son Elijah or entertaining thousands of fans with one of his many mega-hits, Atkins expresses a refreshing simplicity and sincerity that reflects the values he holds so dear: Putting family first, making the most of what you have, and staying true to yourself in a rapidly-changing world.

With the February 2015 release of his first-ever hits compilation, Rodney Atkins – Greatest Hits, the award-winning singer/songwriter shares 11 of his best-loved songs – including his six No. 1 smashes “Take A Back Road,” “It’s America,” “Cleaning This Gun (Come On In Boy),” “These Are My People,” “Watching You” and “If You’re Going Through Hell (Before the Devil Even Knows)” – and puts a fresh spin on the simple pleasures of everyday love with his brand new single, “Eat Sleep Love You Repeat.”

Rodney Atkins – Greatest Hits is Atkins' fifth album via longtime label home Curb Records. His last studio album, Take A Back Road (produced by Ted Hewitt), yielded Atkins' sixth career No. 1 hit and fastest-rising single to date with the title track. “Take A Back Road,” written by Luke Laird and Rhett Akins, was also named Song of the Year at the 2012 BMI Awards and marked Rodney's third Song of the Year win – “Watching You” (2007 / Brian White) and “If You're Going Through Hell” (2006 / Sam and Annie Tate) also earned the title.

When he's not in the studio working on new music, Rodney is working hard out on the road, connecting with loyal fans in cities across the country. An avid supporter of our military, he completed his third USO entertainment tour to Kuwait and Afghanistan in 2014, also one of the last entertainment tours to Afghanistan, and continues to headline dates across the country.

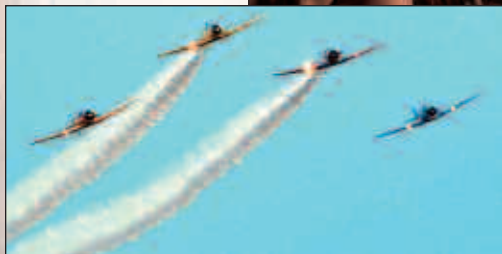
One fateful night as he slept, his living

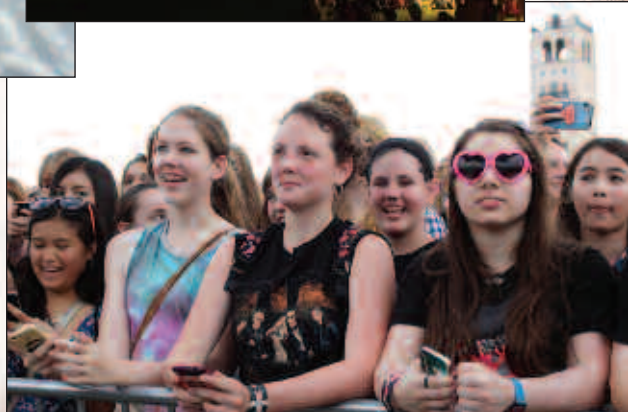

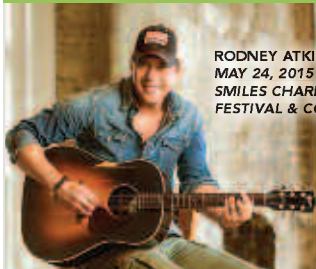

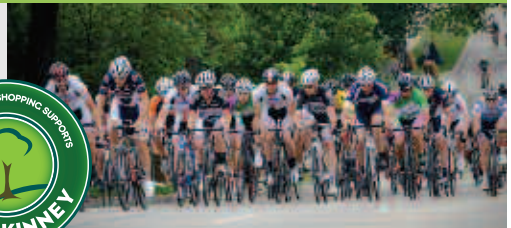
