New

Includes a list of definitions and the other items have been moved to other locations in the revised code.

Change name of department from PROS to Parks and Recreation and moved to Article IV.

Eliminates the listing of all park sites as part of the code.

Moved all rules and regulations into Article V.

Regulations & procedures are included throughout the code including Article I, Article III, and Article V	Consolidates the regulations and procedures into Article V. Some of the regulations have been modified and redundant

Article VII: Permitting Process

Existing	New
Does not exist.	Allows for a process to be used for outside groups to apply for permission to block of areas of a facility or park for private use by groups less than 75 people, thus precluding access by the general public.
	Provides a list of criteria for consideration regarding approval.
	Provides an appeal process for applicants who have been denied approval at the department level.
