








What is the McKinney Senior Services Alliance?

- Participants visited local businesses and landmarks as well as learned fun, historical facts about McKinney.














How I Spy McKinney (2021) benefited McKinney:

The event enhanced the quality of life for McKinney residents












The event showcased local businesses such as:










The event showcased local landmarks such as:










The event attracted McKinney residents and non-residents:

- Each participant received a t-shirt and gift bag with promotional items from businesses.










I Spy McKinney – What's New This Year

- All proceeds will benefit Meals on Wheels Collin County.












I Spy McKinney – Sponsorship & Fundraising Opportunities



- We anticipate approximately 75-80% of our gross revenue to come from our sponsorships. Approximate 20% of our revenue will come from registration fees from the scavenger hunt.
- We will offer multiple fundraising opportunities as well as booth spaces for smaller entertainment venues looking to promote their locations.











I Spy McKinney – Rules of Event



- Each site will include a task and once completed, the team will receive a playing card and an entry blank to be used in the prize give aways at Hub121.
- Using 5 cards from the 10 cards collected, each team is encouraged to make their best poker hand which will result in another prize awarded.











Financial Outlook

- General Donations














Metrics to Evaluate Success
