Strategic Plan Management & Communicating Results:

A. Business Retention & Expansion

- Project Sweet is still evolving & will likely be presented for incentive consideration at the September board meeting.
- The incentive offer letter for Project Edith Ann has been forwarded to the company & is currently under review.
- The amended incentive agreement has been sent to Playful Corp. for their execution.
- Have met with a local company with manufacturing operations in two other states to discuss potential for relocating some portion of those operations to McKinney. Maintaining regular communication.

B. Business Attraction

- A site visit for Project Cake was held on 8/31. Despite very positive feedback from the company's construction consultant, McKinney has been eliminated from contention primarily due to the site control/timing issues; further evidence that our competitiveness goal outlined in our strategic plan is spot on & should be accelerated.
- Preparing some incentive options for Project Cubby which is a speculative office project. Abby Liu will present the options (in my absence) for board feedback/consideration.
- Depart for the Dallas Regional Chamber trade mission to London/Paris on September 6th. In addition to the appointments as part of the regional mission, my London and Partners/London Co-Investment Fund contacts have arranged for me to present McKinney to a group of at least 14 technology companies with interests in expanding operations into the U.S.

C. Entrepreneurship



 Planning continues between the WERX group & the Dallas Entrepreneur Center (DEC) to present a new collaborative model for MEDC Board consideration in October.

D. Competitiveness

 Will monitor progress on both Hunt Southwest & Southgate projects during my travels.

Marketing/Promotion/Connection Activities:

- MEDC sponsored the BisNow DICE (data center) event on 8/31. We had a booth & generated some good leads & also promoted McKinney as a prime location for data center operations.
- Geneva Aragon joined the MEDC Team on 8/28 as Director of Marketing & Research.
