- RFP-Pygmy Goat Convention, June 2020, 500 attendees, 150 room nights, using Myers Park. Preparing the bid proposal (due June 2019, Boise, Idaho), host hotel, and a Banquet for 250 attendees.

Advertising:

- We hit a snag in getting CrowdRiff, the user generated content application, added to our website, but the initial galleries finally went live on Tuesday, June 12. CrowdRiff had to write some special script in order to function within Civic Plus. The same thing happened when we were implementing Visit Widget into our site. There are still a few things they are tweaking to fit within the available space, but we're excited to finally have that up and running. It'll give our web visitors more to look at to keep them on our site longer.
- Beth and Cortney took part in a webinar about the use of chatbots in dealing with travelers.
- Dee-dee and Beth met with Magda Dia with Jump Into Art about promoting events and possible collaboration for McKinney Art Studio Tour this November.
- MCVB is doing a cooperative sponsorship with Main Street for this year's Texas
 Downtown Association Conference. This sponsorship provides McKinney Main
 Street staff with registration for the conference.
- We secured a very last minute remnant ad space in Southern Living's Fall Travel Issue distributed in five states – TX, OK, LA, AR, and MO – with a circulation of 576,000 for \$1564 (usually \$6254).
- Advertising The McKinney Shop in the three high school sports programs and in the Stonebridge Ranch News.
- Revamping the online Meeting Planners Guide to make it all digital. Many of the pages are already complete and old files have been removed. Thanks to Susan Mardele for her help working with Beth to get the new pages set up.
- Kicked off our #VisitMcKinneyFun contest/game in the interest of collecting more quality social media pictures for our new Crowd Riff galleries and for future advertising and promotion.
- A writer from County Line Magazine contacted the MCVB for contact and other information about the food tours available in McKinney. Resulted in a 2/3 page article in their July/August issue, worth print value of \$1675 and a PR value of \$5025 of free publicity.
