

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-07-___

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS ESTABLISHING REDUCED SPEED SCHOOL ZONES FOR WILLOW WOOD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN MCKINNEY, TEXAS; AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THE CAPTION OF THE ORDINANCE, EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF AND A PENALTY CLAUSE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends the Code of Ordinances by adding a section in Chapter 62, Article V, to be numbered 62 – 315, which will read as follows:

Sec 62-315. Willow Wood Elementary School – Zone Designated.

The Willow Wood Elementary School zone shall be:

- (1) On County Road 278 beginning a point 200 feet west of Parkdale Drive and extending eastward along County Road 278 to a point 905 feet east of Parkdale Drive.
- (2) On Parkdale Drive beginning a point 800 feet south of County Road 278 and extending northward along Parkdale Drive to County Road 278.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends the Code of Ordinances by adding a section in Chapter 62, Article V, to be numbered 62 – 315.1, which will read as follows:

Sec 62-315.1 Same – Speed.

The speed limit for the vehicles traveling the streets within the Willow Wood Elementary School zone during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., school days, shall be 20 miles per hour maximum.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its final passage and publication as provided by law, after all the necessary signs and markings have been installed, and it is accordingly so ordained.

Section 4. Any person who violates any provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2000).
