A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE NOMINATION OF A PROJECT FOR THE TXDOT TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, the Transportation Enhancement Program is a federal program funded through the Surface Transportation Program, administered by the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) for the Federal Highway Administration; and
- WHEREAS, the Transportation Enhancement Program offers funding for non-traditional activities which include pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure and safety programs, scenic and historic highway programs, landscaping and scenic beautification, historic preservation, and environmental mitigation; and
- **WHEREAS,** a call for projects has been issued for the Transportation Enhancement Program, during which projects can be nominated for funding; and
- **WHEREAS,** City of McKinney On-Street Bicycle Master Plan elements are eligible to be funded by the Transportation Enhancement Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby supports a Transportation Enhancement Project Submission consisting of on-street bicycle master plan elements and expressly commits to the recommendation, implementation, development, construction, maintenance, and financing of the project.
- Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to submit a nomination for a Transportation Enhancement project that consists of on-street bicycle master plan elements with a total cost of \$250,000 and local cash funds in the amount of \$50,000.
- Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
