

MINUTES

CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF JANUARY 18, 1993

The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, met in special session in the Council Chamber of the Municipal Building on January 18, 1993, at 5:15 p.m.

Councilmembers present were: Mayor John Gay, George Reyna, Charles McKissick, Frank Kerby, Kelly Boatman, and Kelly Davis. Mayor Pro Tempore Willie Wattley was absent.

Staff present were: City Manager Donald E. Paschal, Jr.; Economic Development Coordinator Tom Palmer; and, City Secretary Jennifer G. Smith.

There were no guests present.

Mayor Gay presided.

Mr. Paschal explained that the following Order canvasses the January 16, 1993, Special Election results. Mr. Paschal stated that votes were received as follows:


PROPOSITION NO. 1

THE ADOPTION OF A SALES AND USE TAX FOR THE PROMOTION AND DEVELOPMENT OF NEW AND EXPANDED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES AT THE RATE OF 1/2 OF ONE PERCENT.

FOR	-	935 votes
AGAINST	-	691 votes


On a motion by Councilmember McKissick, seconded by Councilmember Davis, Council unanimously approved the Order. (Exhibit I)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 92-11-38 of the City of McKinney, Texas, adopted on the 17th day of November, 1992, an election was duly held on the 16th day of January, 1993, at the McKinney City Hall in the City of McKinney for the purpose of voting "FOR" or "AGAINST" the adoption of a sales and use tax for the promotion and development of new and expanded business enterprises at the rate of 1/2 of one percent; and,

WHEREAS, said election was held with the solemnities and formalities necessary to make it a valid election, all notices having been posted in the manner and for the length of time required by law; and,

WHEREAS, there appears on said ballots the following proposition, to wit:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

THE ADOPTION OF A SALES AND USE TAX FOR THE PROMOTION AND DEVELOPMENT OF NEW AND EXPANDED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES AT THE RATE OF 1/2 OF ONE PERCENT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, having received said returns within the required length of time after the election was held and having carefully canvassed the votes and finding that:

"FOR"	-	935 votes
"AGAINST"	-	691 votes


