The "McKinney Expressions with a Twist" workshop focused on bringing the importance of art through our daily lives; to combine human behaviors and art was successfully presented, which as a follow-up being used today by the attendants in group therapy and classrooms.

With each presenter, a variety of activities kept the audience engaged.


