The McKinney Community Development Corporation Potential Projects

Subcommittee met via Zoom at 5:00 p.m. on February 2, 2023.

The Potential Projects Subcommittee met with developer, design team and owner of

The Cotton Mill to discuss progress on a possible mixed-use development at the site. The

developer has been working on the project for more than two years and is presenting to this

subcommittee as a follow-up to a May 2021 presentation. The Cotton Mill will be the focal

point of the development which will include multi-family and artist lofts, two office buildings

totaling over 100,000 square feet, retail, restaurants, a boutique hotel and public green

space. The indoor and outdoor gathering areas will celebrate and pay homage to the history

and artistic scene of The Cotton Mill including layout of stonework to mimic rugs. Residential

options will allocate 10% for attainable housing units.

The developer will continue meeting with city departments to gain site plan and

variance approvals and plans to make a request in an amount of about \$5.9 million to MCDC

for development of the public spaces. The developer shared that the estimated 20-year

economic impact of this project to the community is about \$933 million, 4,500 new jobs and

\$41.4 million in property and sales tax.
