

**RESOLUTION NO. 2014-06-\_\_\_ (R)**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY,  
TEXAS ADOPTING THE STATE HIGHWAY 5 CORRIDOR CONTEXT  
SENSITIVE MASTER PLAN**

**WHEREAS,** in 2010, the Regional Transportation Council (RTC) of the North Central Texas Council of Governments selected the SH 5 Corridor Context Sensitive Transportation Study (SH 5 Corridor Study) for grant funding through the Sustainable Development program; and

**WHEREAS,** in 2012, the City of McKinney, Texas and the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) entered into an interlocal agreement to conduct the State Highway 5 Corridor Context Sensitive Transportation Study; and

**WHEREAS,** the SH 5 Corridor Study formally began in 2013 and included an analysis of existing conditions, identification of issues and opportunities, a series of public outreach events, the development of design parameters and creation of conceptual design alternatives; and

**WHEREAS,** the SH 5 Corridor Context Sensitive Transportation Master Plan (SH 5 Master Plan) serves as the conclusion to the SH 5 Corridor Study and provides a summary of the planning initiative as well as recommendations for conceptual design alternatives; and

**WHEREAS,** the SH 5 Master Plan establishes a context sensitive vision for the long-term planning and revitalization of State Highway 5 through McKinney; and

**WHEREAS,** the State Highway 5 Corridor is recognized as a major regional thoroughfare by the Regional Transportation Council of the North Central Texas Council of Governments; and

**WHEREAS,** it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of McKinney that the State Highway 5 Corridor Context Sensitive Master Plan be adopted by the City Council to provide a framework for the future development of State Highway 5 through McKinney.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:**

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas adopts the State Highway 5 Corridor Context Sensitive Master Plan, as depicted in Exhibit A.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
