

HISTORIC PRESERVATION ADVISORY BOARD

OCTOBER 4, 2012

The Historic Preservation Advisory Board of the City of McKinney, Texas met in regular session in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building on Thursday, October 4, 2012 @ 5:30 p.m.

Board Members Present: Chairman Thomas McKissick, Randy Hubbard, Edna Brown, Kevin McGraw, and Wes Shannon.

Board Members Absent: Mark McReynolds and Melanie Morgan.

Chairman McKissick called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. after determining a quorum was present.

12-824 Oath of Office.

12-825 Election of Chair and Vice-Chair.

Mr. Guy Giersch, Historic Preservation Officer for the City of McKinney, continued the meeting with the election for a Chair and Vice-Chair.
