

Habitat for Humanity of Collin County requests to extend the Term on the Loan Agreement for Project #20-03 to March 31, 2022 and to amend the Terms of the Grant Award for Project #20-03 as follows:



### The grant is detailed below

\$9,800	Tree Trimming	\$150
\$23,400	Concrete Surface for Playground	\$13,570
\$950	Shade Structure Engineering	\$0
\$773,224	TOTAL AMOUNT	\$587,708.36

To date, Habitat has requested reimbursement for \$199,235.64


## Habitat for Humanity® of Collin County

- 1. Funding the construction of Playground Shade Structure through the reallocation of the remaining funds previously awarded for a concrete surface, in the amount of \$13,570.00, and
- 2. Reallocation of the remaining funds previously awarded for Tree Trimming, in the amount of \$150, and through an increase in funding in the amount of \$26,087.58 for an aggregate total award of \$39, 807.58






3. Funding the construction of the Amenity Center through a grant increase in the amount of \$250,000.00, resulting in an aggregate total grant for the Amenity Center of \$500,000.00





#### SUMMARY

Aggregate of all additional funding requests equals \$289,807.58.
