(3) Signs interfering with traffic. Signs that imitate an official traffic sign or signal, or which contain the words "stop," "go slow," "caution," "danger," "warning" or similar words used on official traffic signs or signals. Signs which are of a size, location, movement, content, coloring or manner of illumination which may be confused with or construed as a traffic control device or which hide from view any traffic or street sign or signal, or which obstruct the view in any direction at a street or road intersection.

(c) Signs Interfering with Traffic⁵

Any sign that imitates an official traffic sign or signal. Any sign that is of a size, location, movement, coloring, or manner of illumination that may be confused with or construed as a traffic control device; or that hides from view any traffic or street sign or signal; or that obstructs the view in any direction at a street or road intersection.







• Variance – a process where an applicant can ask for relieve from the technical requirements (height, size, etc.) of the ordinance.

- Apply for sign permit
- Staff consideration and action
- Appealed to City Council

Proposed

- Apply for sign permit
- Staff consideration and action
- o Appealed to:
 - Sign Board (BOA) or
 - City Council (content-based appeals)

Meritorious Exception

Meritorious Exception Process

• Meritorious Exception – process by which an applicant can propose an innovative sign for an appropriate site or location.

Current

- Apply for meritorious exception
- Staff review and recommendation
- City Council consideration & action

Proposed

- Apply for meritorious exception
- Staff consideration and action
- Appeal to Sign Board (BOA)
