



**CDBG-CV EMERGENCY LIVING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
DUPLICATION OF BENEFITS AFFIDAVIT**

PURPOSE:

The City of McKinney is a grantee under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and has received funding under the CARES Act, under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV), to assist eligible McKinney residents with rental, mortgage, or utility assistance. As such, must establish and maintain adequate procedures to prevent any duplication of benefits for this type of activity. Food and water assistance are not eligible under this program and the City will utilize program nonprofit agencies to assist residents with the application process. The affidavit is a document requirement of the application.

DEFINITION:

A duplication of benefits occurs when a person, household, business, government, or other entity receives federal financial assistance from multiple sources for the same purpose, and the total assistance that is received for that purpose is more than the total need for assistance to the person and/or household. The city must check to see that subrecipients, assisted individuals or families, and other entities that receive CDBG-CV assistance have not previously received, or will not receive, duplicative assistance from another source before requested CDBG-CV assistance is provided.

The City of McKinney is accomplishing this duplication of benefits analysis by requiring both subrecipients and beneficiaries to provide a self-certification indicating that they have not received, and do not reasonably anticipate receiving a duplicative benefit. It will be also required to list potentially duplicative assistance that they have already received, or reasonably anticipate receiving. Households receiving assistance under HUD through Public Housing, Section 8/Housing Choice Vouchers are not assistance eligible for CDBG-CV funding as HUD has provided other resources.
