

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-08-____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS ESTABLISHING REDUCED SPEED SCHOOL ZONES FOR ROCK HILL HIGH SCHOOL IN FRISCO, TEXAS; AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THE CAPTION OF THE ORDINANCE, EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF AND A PENALTY CLAUSE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends the Code of Ordinances by adding a section in Chapter 62, Article V, to be numbered 62 – 325, which will read as follows:

Sec 62-225. Rock Hill High School – Zone Designated.

The Rock Hill High School zone shall be:

(1) On Northbound Coit Road beginning a point 355 feet south of Jackboro Lane and extending northward along Coit Road to a point 100 feet north of Hardy Drive.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby amends the Code of Ordinances by adding a section in Chapter 62, Article V, to be numbered 62 – 325.1, which will read as follows:

Sec 62-325.1 Same – Speed.

The speed limit for the vehicles traveling the streets within the Rock Hill High School zone during the hours of 7:35 a.m. to 8:35 a.m. and 3:55 p.m. to 4:35 p.m., school days, shall be 20 miles per hour maximum.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its final passage and publication as provided by law, after all the necessary signs and markings have been installed, and it is accordingly so ordained.

Section 4. Any person who violates any provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2000).
