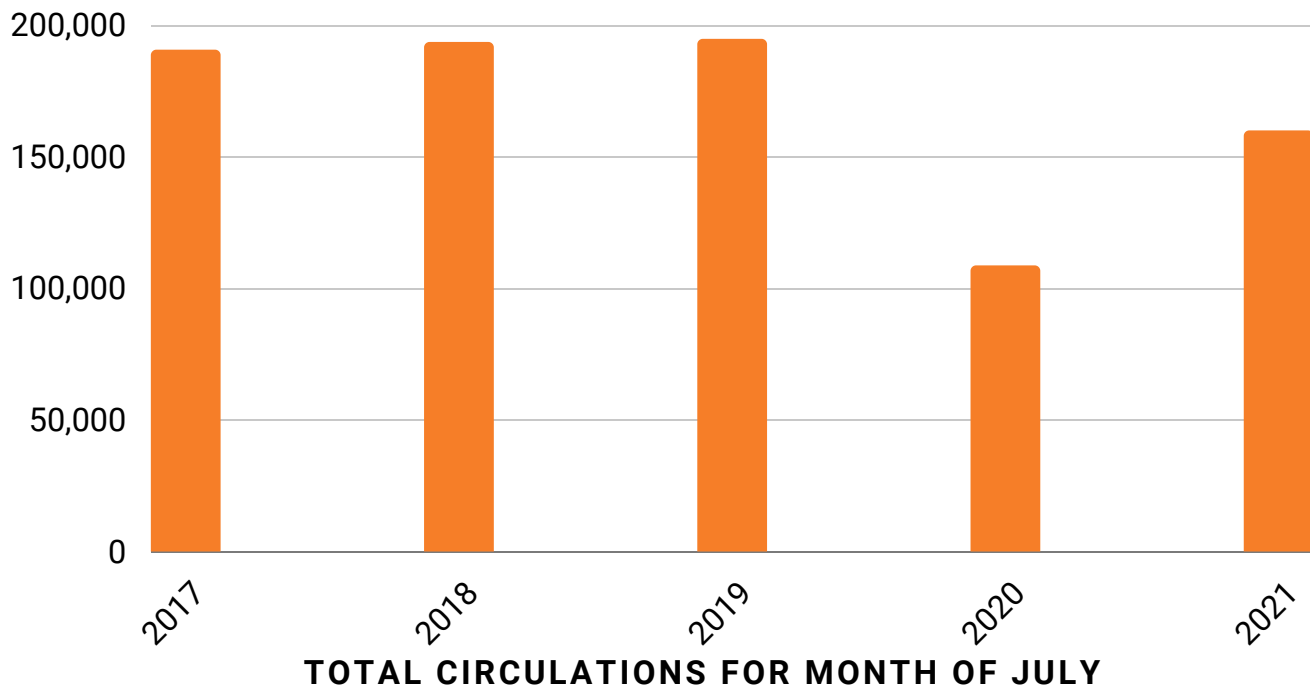
In certain areas the library has not returned to pre-pandemic levels of use, July did showcase some areas of growth for the McKinney Libraries, specifically in programming. We saw growth both total program attendance and average attendance per program over 2019 and 2018 totals. There were 2940 attendees for 80 total programs in July, for a 6% increase per program over 2019.

Total Circulation in July 2021 was only at 82% of circulation in July 2019, even with program attendance up. This is due, in large part, to our visitor count only reaching 77% of 2019 July totals. Visitors checked out 4.1 items per visit in July 2021, vs 3.9 items in July 2019.
