

Homeless Services Team Recommendations

1. Recommendation of specific policy changes needed to improve library service delivery to McKinney's homeless population

- After review the Homeless Services Team determined no changes are needed for the library's Code of Conduct. The team will continue to monitor the needs of this population to determine if policies need to be changed.

2. Identify and recommend onboarding and training resources needed to help staff deliver library services to the homeless population.

- After interviewing and surveying different staff members at both libraries, the Homeless Services Team determined that onboarding and training resources should include:
 - Sensitivity training and scripts for how to interact with patrons experiencing homelessness.
 - Guidelines for what behaviors require a verbal warning, dismissal from the facility, or criminal trespassing.
- The following are possible resources for onboarding and training:

 - An annual subscription would be \$539 for 50 staff members
 - Includes 3 hours of video training that can be broken up into 2-10 minute modules.
