RESOLUTION NO. 2011-03-___ (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS TO RECEIVE A \$38,646 CLEAN FLEETS NORTH TEXAS GRANT FOR CONVERTING THREE PRIUSES TO ELECTRIC PLUG-IN HYBRIDS.

- **WHEREAS**, the City Council understands that Collin County is in the Dallas-Fort Worth non-attainment area for ozone, an impediment to economic development and a health risk for its citizens, and
- **WHEREAS**, almost half of all emissions in the Dallas-Fort Worth non-attainment area are generated by the combustion engines of cars and trucks, and
- WHEREAS, NCTCOG encourages cities to operate the cleanest fleets possible, cutting emissions in order to reach attainment of the ozone standards under the Clean Air Act, and
- **WHEREAS**, by the City's converting three of its fleet Priuses to electric plug-in hybrids it reduces its ozone-causing emissions as well as its carbon footprint, and
- **WHEREAS**, the grant's required twenty percent matching funds can be satisfied by applying the residual value of the three vehicles so that the City's share is inkind without requiring any expenditure of funds,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby accepts the contract with the North Central Texas Council of Governments for a \$38,646 Clean Fleets North Texas Grant.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the contract with the North Central Texas Council of Governments for a \$38,646 Clean Fleets North Texas Grant.
- Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
