

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-03-____(R)

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION GRANT FROM THE GOVERNOR'S CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION FOR A JUVENILE CASE MANAGER

WHEREAS, Texas Senate Bill 61 imposes additional duties on Juvenile Case Managers in the oversight and management of juvenile cases coming through the Municipal Court system; and

WHEREAS, the State of Texas is providing the competitive Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (JJDP) grant to assist with implementation of these additional duties; and

WHEREAS, on November 11, 2011, Agenda Item 2011-11-114, City Council approved the revised Guidelines for Juvenile Case Managers required by the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of McKinney that the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention grant be implemented during the 2011-2012 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the City Manager, or his designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the agreement on behalf of the applicant agency

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas approves the submission and acceptance of the grant application for a Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Grant, from the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division to fund an a Juvenile Case Manager

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
