Historical Legacy in McKinney

- Heard-Craig Structure built 120 years ago.
- Opened to the public 50 years ago.
- Today it's a multi-use facility and museum.
- Listed in the National Register of Historic Places by the United States Department of the Interior.
- The Heard-Craig provides \$300,000 worth of meeting space each year to educationally-based organizations. The preservation of the facility allows for the continuation of philanthropic donations to McKinney groups.



Preservation Project **Grant Eligibility** under Sections 501 and 505 of the Texas Local Government Code

- Improvement Project expands business in McKinney
- Assists in job creation
- Project related to community facility with city/public access
- Entertainment/Tourist Facility

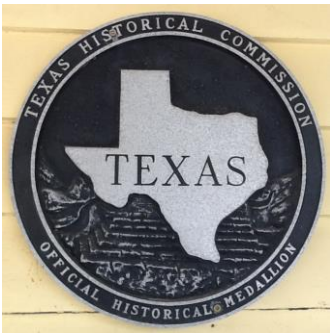

 - Two basement floods (rain/sump pump equipment stopped)
 - Electrical issues
 - Rotting soffits
 - Water Damage
 - Holes in the Porch
 - Peeling Paint
