

**Park Board Report  
McKinney Community Center  
July 2014**

*\*\*The McKinney Community Center has been heavily impacted by the construction on 75 Central. We have experienced frustrated customers expressing their challenges trying to locate our facility; in turn, we have seen a drop in enrollment for our programs and fewer people for daily drop in visits.*

**JULY SUMMER PROGRAM ENROLLMENTS**

- **Adventures in Art Camp:** In this program, participants ages 6-13, created 8 different masterpieces with five different mediums (oil, acrylic, water color, oil pastels, charcoal). Subjects ranged from animals to florals, still life's, and land and seascapes. **13 students.**
- **Young Rembrandt Drawing:** This art class taught advanced drawing skills and techniques. **18 participants** (beginner & advance programs were available).
- **Fencing:** Participants learned the art and sport of Olympic fencing. **7 participants.** Program is taught by North Texas Fencing Alliance in McKinney.
- **Junior Players Theater Camp:** Students focused on the creative process that promotes oral communication, creativity, literacy, critical thinking and movement. Free program, max enrollment: **25 participants**
- **All Star Sports Camp:** An awesome sports program that introduces a variety of sports to include basketball, soccer, flag football, Frisbee, and kickball. **10 students.**
- **Basketball Camp:** This clinic was designed for players of all skills and abilities focusing on dribbling, passing, shooting and rebounding. **12 students**
- **Childcare Babysitting Program:** The perfect course for participants ages 11-15 who has an interest in babysitting. Course helps build confidence, self-esteem, and skills necessary to care for infants and children on a daily basis and in an emergency. **12 participants enrolled.** **\*\*This course is very popular during the summer and is offered once a month.**

- **Adult CPR & First Aid:** Students who completed this course should be prepared and have the set skills to recognize the signs and symptoms of injuries and sudden illness. Crucial information for how to deal with emergencies like bleeding, shock, burns, etc... This program satisfies the requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration. **13 adults registered.**
- **Youth Tech Web Studio:** This course was a combination of animation and web design classes. Students learned the basics of animation and digital design. **4 enrolled**
- **Game Design Apps:** This course provided students with a fun, interactive look at the world of mobile video game design and development. Students who completed this course learned how to publish games to their favorite Apple or Android devices. **5 enrolled.**
