Baylor Medical Center at McKinney

Baylor Medical Center at McKinney is a 95-bed, \$91.7 million facility located at the northwest corner of University Drive (Highway 380) and Lake Forest Drive in McKinney, Texas. The 469,000 square-foot, full-service medical center opened in July 2012 and is dedicated to serving the residents of McKinney and surrounding communities.

Baylor McKinney has more than 600 medical staff members, representing 63 medical specialties and sub-specialties. Baylor McKinney is the first Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) or green building among Baylor's four Collin County hospitals.

As part of the medical center's long-term plans, the hospital structure can add additional floors, increasing the number of beds to 400 as community growth warrants. The campus also has an adjacent medical office building for private physician practices.

HIGHLIGHTS

Cancer Care

From surgery to counseling to rehabilitation, we provide services that cover the entire continuum of care for cancer patients and their families. Physicians in the adjacent office building also provide onsite chemotherapy and radiation therapy for most types of cancer.

Digestive Disease

We have created a comfortable and thoughtful diagnostic facility for procedures, such as colonoscopy or endoscopic ultrasound, where care and privacy are of the utmost importance.

Emergency Department

When an emergency happens, our doors are always open. Emergency care is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Heart and Vascular Services

Baylor McKinney offers everything from prevention and assessment to cardiac interventional therapies and vascular surgery. The hospital is also home to the outpatient Center for Advanced Cardiovascular Care, where patients with complex and multifaceted cardiovascular disease can receive evaluation, testing and treatment from a team of experts each specializing in various aspects of their condition, usually in a single visit.

Imaging Services

For patients needing a CT scan, an MRI or other imaging exam, we have a fully equipped diagnostic center that can handle advanced imaging needs in a timely, efficient manner. Additionally, the Baylor Women's Imaging Center at McKinney, located on the Baylor McKinney campus, has been designated a Breast Imaging Center of Excellence by the American College of Radiology. It is the only imaging center in McKinney to achieve this status and offers digital mammography, stereotaxis, breast ultrasound and more.

Intensive Care

In addition to our 10 intensive care private suites, Baylor McKinney utilizes in-house, board-certified intensivists around-the-clock who are specially trained in treating patients in the ICU.



Internal Medicine - Hospitalists

Specially trained internal medicine physicians, called hospitalists, care for our inpatients. Hospitalists work alongside primary care physicians and specialists to address the health care needs of our patients. In addition to hospitalists, the medical staff at Baylor McKinney includes numerous internal medicine physicians practicing a variety of specialties.

Neurology Services

When faced with a neurological issue, patients want to know they are in good hands. Baylor McKinney offers one-stop access to physicians and a care team with expertise in diagnosing and managing conditions such as epilepsy, Parkinson's disease, Alzheimer's disease and other conditions.

Orthopedics

From hip and knee replacement to sports medicine, the orthopedic specialists at Baylor McKinney combine personalized care with expertise to offer a full range of orthopedic care services, including anterior hip replacement.

Surgical Services

Whatever your surgery needs, Baylor McKinney has experienced surgeons and surgical nursing staff ready to handle your patient care from diagnosis to discharge. We offer many minimally invasive procedures, as well as robotic-assisted surgery.

Women and Infant Services

At Baylor McKinney, we recognize the special health care needs of women and infants, which is why we offer patient-centered, family-oriented care in a range of specialties. From obstetrics and gynecology to breast health services, we are here for women at every stage of life. We also offer a Level III NICU with private suites.



- The building's dove design enhances nurse workflow and patient safety, allowing for visibility to guest suites from nursing stations strategically placed within the unit.
- Electronic health records are used throughout the facility.
- Processes and teams are already making significant strides towards national qualityrelated certifications like Stroke, Chest Pain, Heart Failure and Cancer Center accreditation.
- Established "Care Transitions Advocate" to advance work in reducing readmissions going forward.
- Volunteers provided more than 12,800 hours of service to the hospital during its first year.
- The first floor contains surgical services, imaging, heart and vascular services, intensive care unit and an emergency department, all of which can grow into adjacent shell space.
- The second floor includes labor and delivery, private neonatal intensive care suites, well-baby nursery, and Simply Mom's boutique.
- Third floor is home to medical/surgical and telemetry suites and a dialysis suite.
- Fourth and fifth floors are shelled out to accomodate future growth.
