

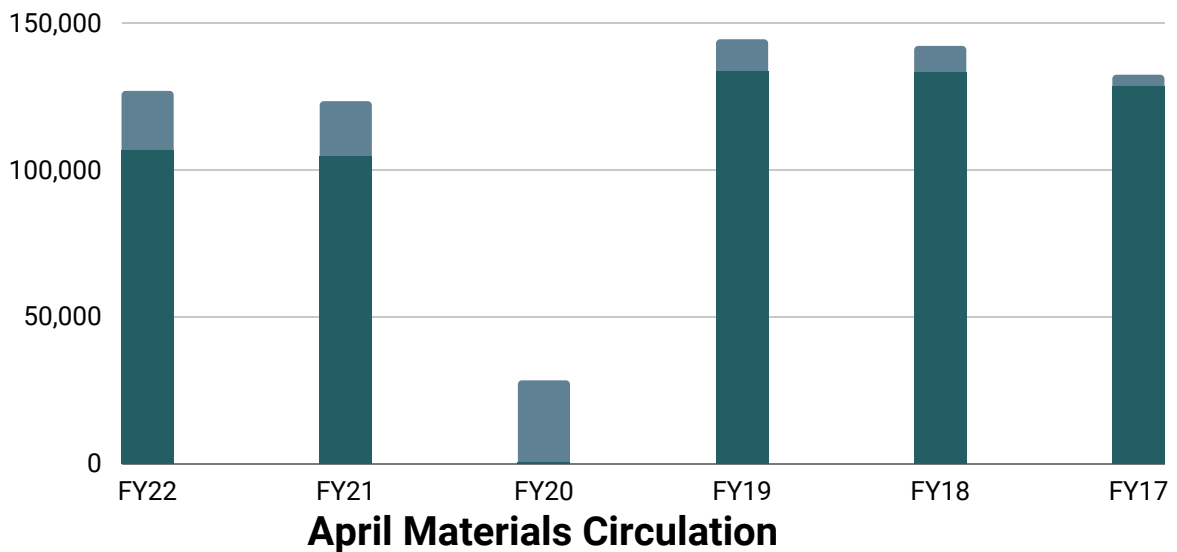

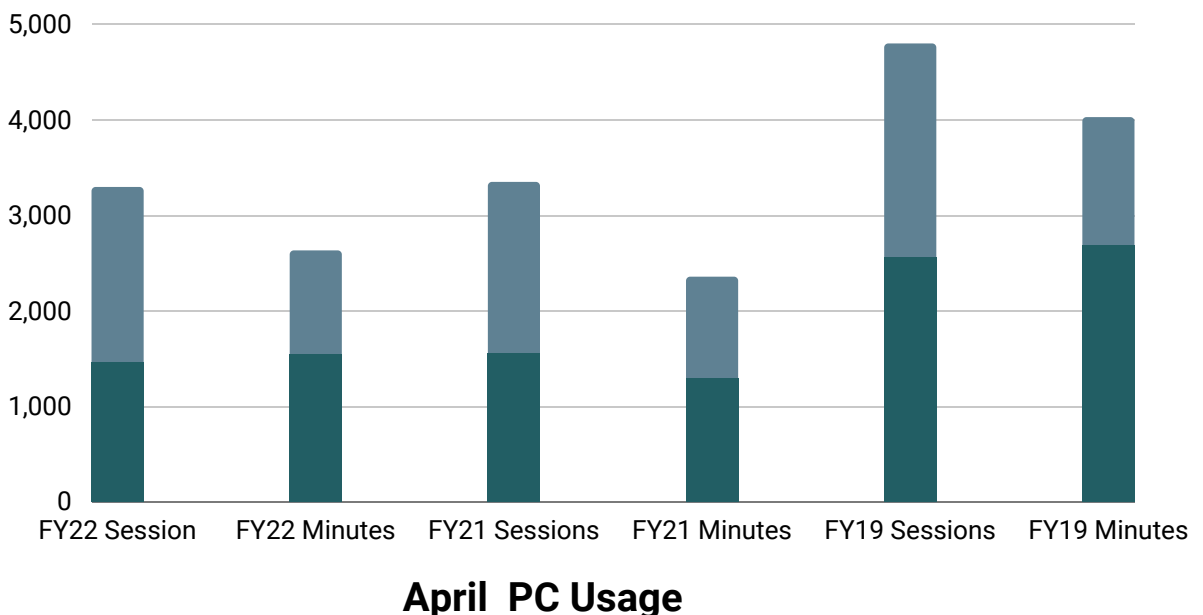


# By the Numbers

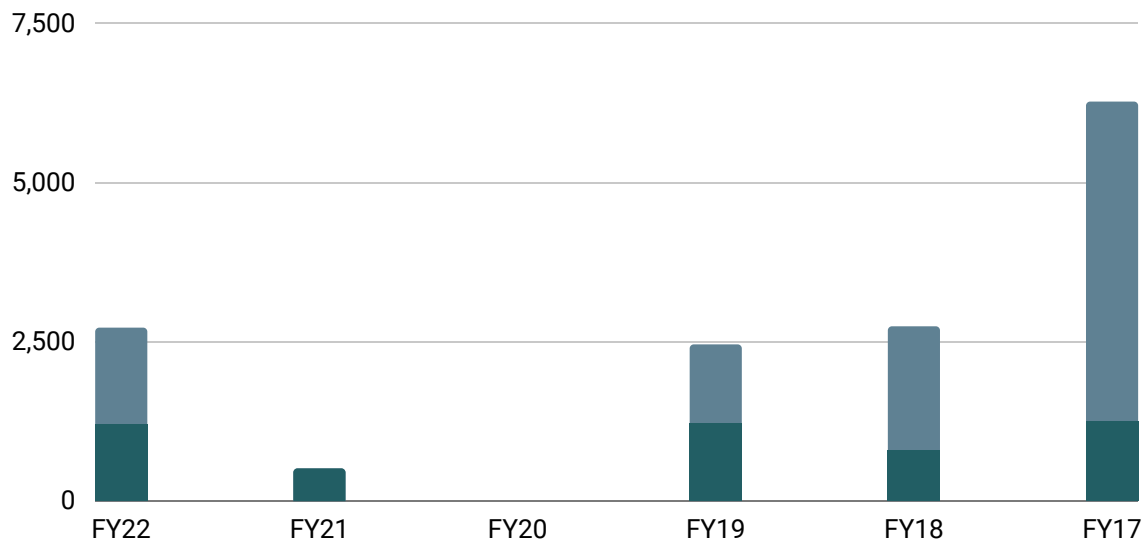
Overall circulation, including digital items, was higher in April, 2022 than April of 2021 or 2020, but only at 88% of April 2019's totals. However, digital checkouts continue to hold strong above 20,000 in the month.



There were slightly fewer PC sessions in April 2022 compared to 2021, but the sessions lasted longer. Both measures are down compared to pre-pandemic use.

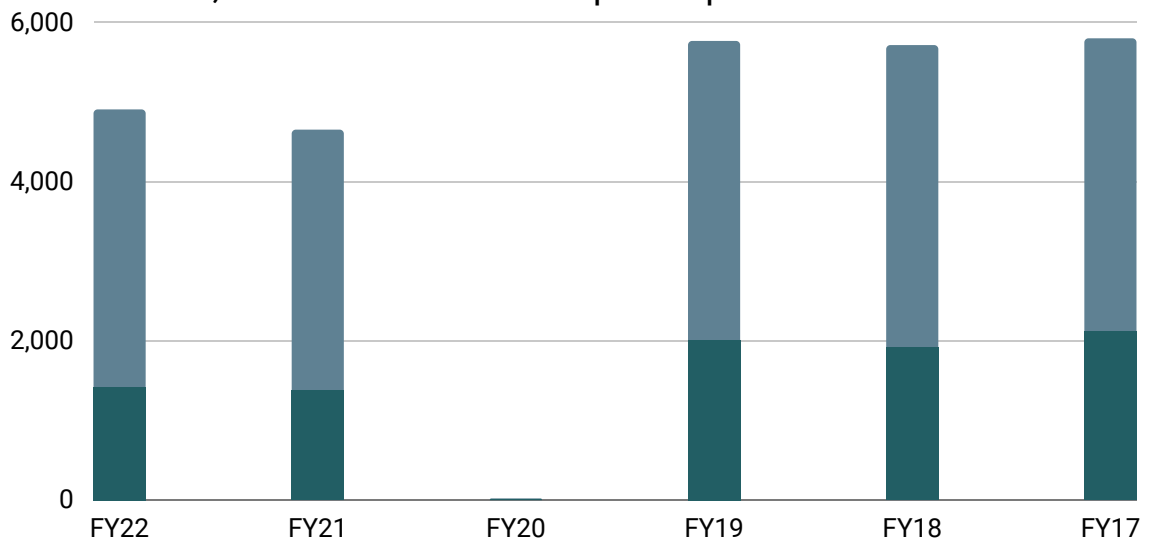


More people attended programs in April 2022 than in April of 21. April was on par with 2019, mostly due to large outreach presence at Arts in Bloom.

The number of unique cardholders who checked out in April increased over April, 2021 at both locations. Hall, however, is only at 67% of its peak April for users in 2019, and JJGL is at 92% of peak April for users in 2018
