

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-09-___ (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER, OR AUTHORIZED DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN FRISCO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, CITY OF FRISCO, TEXAS, AND CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS REGARDING THE MOONEYHAM ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, authorizes governmental entities to contract with each other to perform governmental functions and services under the terms thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, has before it the proposed Interlocal Agreement between Frisco Independent School District, City of Frisco, Texas, and City of McKinney, Texas, attached hereto, which provides the terms and conditions of the Mooneyham Elementary School project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, finds the proposed Interlocal Agreement between Frisco Independent School District, City of Frisco, and City of McKinney will promote the parties' valid governmental interest in protecting the health, safety and welfare of children traveling to and from school in the region.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City of McKinney, Texas, and are fully incorporated into the body of the Resolution.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, after reviewing the terms and conditions of the Interlocal Agreement, hereby approves the attached Interlocal Agreement between Frisco Independent School District, City of Frisco, Texas and City of McKinney, Texas regarding the Mooneyham Elementary School project.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby authorizes the Interim City Manager, or his Authorized Designee, to execute on behalf of the City of McKinney, Texas the Interlocal Agreement with Frisco Independent School District and City of Frisco, Texas and all other documents connection therewith.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
