A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH WALL ENTERPRISES OF WHITEWRIGHT, TEXAS, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE ASH WOODS PARK BRIDGE **PROJECT** 

- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, has determined a need for a pedestrian bridge and hike and bike trail at Ash Woods Park near Mooneyham Elementary School. This will provide better pedestrian access to area schools and adjacent park land; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council approved the budget on September 15, 2015; and
- WHEREAS, the project has been bid in a manner consistent with State Law; and
- WHEREAS, a bid evaluation resulted in the selection of Wall Enterprises as the lowest, responsive bidder; and
- WHEREAS, the City has prepared a contract with Wall Enterprises to construct the Ash Woods Park Bridge Project (PK4368).

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby accepts the bid in the amount of \$156,555 to construct the Ash Woods Park Bridge project.
- Section 2. The Interim City Manager is authorized to execute a contract with Wall Enterprises in the amount of \$156,555.
- The contract with Walls Enterprises for construction of the Ash Woods Park Section 3. Bridge project shall not exceed \$172,555 which provides funds for the base bid plus an approximate 10% contingency (\$16,000).
- Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
