A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER, OR THEIR DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT AND IMPLEMENT THE GRANT AWARD COMBINING EXISTING URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY THROUGH THE NORTH TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (NCTCOG) TO PURCHASE A MULTI-USE, MASS CASUALTY INCIDENT (MCI) VEHICLE TO BE HOUSED AT THE MCKINNEY NATIONAL AIRPORT

- **WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, understands the importance enhancing regional security and emergency preparedness; and
- **WHEREAS**, the grant will combine previously awarded grant funding to purchase a multiuse, Mass Casualty Incident (MCI) vehicle; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the UASI funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) in full; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City Council authorizes the Interim City Manager, or their designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the agreement on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby approves the acceptance and implementation of the grant award of Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) funding through the North Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) to purchase a multi-use, Mass Casualty Incident (MCI) vehicle.
- Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
