WHEREAS, at approximately 10:00 a.m., Nick began coaching his teacher on how to perform the Heimlich maneuver; and

WHEREAS, after the teacher was unsuccessful, Nick stepped in and performed the Heimlich maneuver and freed the obstruction from his classmate; and

WHEREAS, Nick's Assistant Scoutmaster Tony Reeder stated: "because of young men like Nick, adults like me stay in Scouting as leaders"; and

WHEREAS, Nick's Scoutmaster William Neubauer stated: "his actions exemplify all that we try to accomplish in Scouting and Troop 2150"; and

WHEREAS, Nick's great leadership during a life threatening situation was instrumental in saving his fellow student.
