

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-02-___ (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND IMPLEMENT A STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM (SHSP) GRANT AWARD FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR (OOG) TO PURCHASE THERMAL IMAGING EQUIPMENT TO SUPPORT THE PROPER EQUIPPING OF POLICE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL RESPONDING TO HIGH RISK INCIDENTS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, understands the importance of enhancing regional security and emergency preparedness; and

WHEREAS, the grant award will be used to fund the purchase of thermal imaging equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the SHSP funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor (OOG) in full; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorizes the City Manager, or designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the agreement on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby approves the acceptance and implementation of the State Homeland Security Program grant award through the Office of the Governor (OOG) to purchase thermal imaging to support the proper equipping of Police personnel responding to high risk incidents.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
