

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-04-___ (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT, IF AWARDED, AN AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021 (ARPA) GRANT FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$148,000 TO PREVENT, PREPARE FOR, AND RESPOND TO THE IMPACTS OF THE COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY ON AIRPORT OPERATIONS AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS RELATIVE TO THE ACCEPTANCE OF SUCH GRANT.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation has made American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) Grants available to general aviation airports, through the Texas Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation acts as agent for the U.S. Department of Transportation for the purposes of applying for, receiving and distributing all aviation grant funds and for the administration of contracts necessary for the implementation of these improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of McKinney/McKinney National Airport has received an offer of financial assistance in the form of a 100% grant of approximately \$148,000, from the Texas Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, funds can be used for costs related to operations, personnel, cleaning, sanitation, janitorial services, combating the spread of pathogens at the airport, and debt service payments

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. That the City Manager, or his designee is hereby authorized to accept an American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) Grant from the Texas Department of Transportation in the estimated amount of \$148,000 to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the impacts of the COVID-19 public health emergency on airport operations. The grant reimburses the McKinney National Airport for 100% of qualifying expenses and requires no matching funds.

Section 2. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to administer to all matters relating to such grant and to execute all necessary documents relative to the acceptance of such grant.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
