A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AS REQUIRED BY THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR FINAL PLAN APPROVAL

- WHEREAS, the City of McKinney, Texas ("City") recognizes the vulnerability of the community to damage, injury, and loss of life and property resulting from natural and man-made disasters and recognizes that we can reduce loss of life and property by lessening the impact of disasters through effective mitigation practices; and
- WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) require communities to adopt a Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP) to be eligible for Hazard Mitigation Assistance including but not limited to Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) Grants and Hazard Mitigation Program Grant (HMGP) funding when available; and
- **WHEREAS**, the HMP identifies the community's potential risks, outlines mitigation goals, and identifies risk reduction strategies to be undertaken by the City to reduce long-term consequences of natural hazards; and
- **WHEREAS**, Adoption by the local governing body demonstrates the Jurisdiction's commitment to fulfilling the hazard mitigation goals and actions outlined in the plan; and legitimizes the plan authorizing responsible agencies to execute their responsibilities; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council deems that HMP adoption is in the best interest of the citizens and the City of McKinney.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of McKinney, Texas hereby adopts the City of McKinney Hazard Mitigation Plan in its entirety, including mitigation actions to be undertaken by the City, subject to available funding.
- Section 2. The City of McKinney will continue to participate in the HMP planning process as required by FEMA and the Texas Division of Emergency Management.
- Section 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.
