A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A LOCAL PROJECT ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT (LPAFA) WITH TXDOT TO FURNISH TRAFFIC SIGNAL EQUIPMENT AT THE US 75 AT WILMETH INTERCHANGE

- **WHEREAS**, the North Texas region continues to experience dramatic growth as the area's population now exceeds 5.7 million people; and
- **WHEREAS**, this dramatic growth is expected to continue with an expected population for the region of 9.0 million people by 2030; and
- WHEREAS, the City of McKinney and Collin County have doubled in population during the last decade with an expected population of 300,000 and 1.2 million people respectively by 2030; and
- **WHEREAS,** motorist delay and congestion on our regional / local thoroughfare networks are expected to double in the next 25 years; and
- **WHEREAS**, reconstruction of the US 75 at Wilmeth interchange will significantly improve mobility for area residents and spur economic development activities along the corridor; and
- **WHEREAS,** furnishing the traffic signal equipment will standardize traffic control equipment in the corridor and thereby reduce maintenance response times.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a Local Project Advance Funding Agreement (LPAFA) with TxDOT to furnish traffic signal equipment at the US 75 at Wilmeth interchange for an amount not to exceed \$40,000.
